The **Adult Dinner** begins at the church at 6 pm. Cost is \$35 per person or \$70 a couple. Guests will gather in the narthex for refreshments. Guests will receive their host's address. Dinners will begin at 7 pm.

Please let Dianne Cardin know if you would like to be a guest or host for either a family or adult dinner. Guests, please note ages of children attending. Everyone, let us know if you have any food or pet allergies or food restrictions. Hosts please indicate how many guests you can accommodate and if you have pets.

➤ **Refugee Fund Year End and Thank you**

In the spring of 2018, the congregation approved sponsoring the reunification of Syrian Christian refugees with their family here who were sponsored by Seaway Presbytery two years ago. With the generous support of BUC members and \$5650 in donations from outside our church, we had, at the end of 2018, raised \$15,901.34 towards our goal of \$24,000. With pledges of \$ 5,310 for 2019 and some more for 2020, plus a few fund raising activities, we expect to make our goal. Bravo BUC for your overwhelming response to bringing this family back together. The applications are with UCC Toronto's Refugee desk, and will be forwarded to Immigration with this spring's allocation. Meanwhile, look for our next "fund-raising" activity – Guess Who's Coming to Dinner.

➤ **Congregational Designated Lay Minister Contract Position Posting**
