VOLUNTEER AT PARKDALE UNITED'S "IN FROM THE COLD" MINISTRY

The 'In from the Cold' Ministry at Parkdale United Church is a wonderful ministry that provides an afternoon of fellowship and a hot meal to over 120 guests every Saturday from the middle of November to the end of March each year. It takes over 60 volunteers each week to run this program. A group of volunteers from BUC has participated in this ministry for the past three years.



Another opportunity to serve dinner and help with the takedown of tables and chairs is available on Saturday, March 2, 2019. We need a group of 17 people to help. Volunteers would need to be at Parkdale United by 2:45pm. The cleanup/takedown is usually finished by 6pm.

A sign-up sheet is in the Narthex. If you are interested in joining this year's serving group, please sign up by no later than February 24th. Since we only have one opportunity to serve this year, priority will be given to those who have never participated in the past. After that, volunteers will be taken in order they appear on the signup sheet. We encourage our youth to volunteer. Hours spent at 'In from the Cold' can count for high school volunteer hours. However, please note that the minimum age for volunteers is 14.

Many thanks to all who supported our Outreach initiatives over the Christmas season, including those who organised and helped with events:

- Come Sing Noel raised \$1264 for the Barrhaven Food Cupboard; and
- \$1200 was sent to each of the three local chaplaincies from financial donations on White Gift Sunday and Outreach donations on Christmas Eve.

> Tornado Relief

The late September tornadoes in Ottawa - Gatineau displaced many families who may not have a home to return to for months.

In October, two Outreach Team members attended a meeting hosted at St Paul's United Church in Carp to discuss ways faith communities might support West Carleton (which includes Dunrobin) residents who were impacted by the tornado. Follow-up with Rev Roi at St. Paul's, a member of the West Carleton Disaster Relief group, indicated that at least nine families have been matched with faith communities who will support them over the long term. An online chart has been set up for other faith groups, including BUC, to offer their gifts that might be used as needs arise. Contact was also made with Knox United and the Trend-Arlington Community Association regarding needs in the Trend-Arlington/Craig Henry area. Following a discussion at Council's November meeting, and thanks to several BUC donors, a \$500 donation was made to the FAMSAC Food Cupboard to assist in supporting mainly Craig Henry families affected by the tornado and \$540 to the West Carleton Food Access Centre for use by West Carleton Disaster Relief in supporting families who are struggling.
