RESOURCE STEWARDSHIP

➤ Updated on Remits

As has been recently posted in the Life and Work, the United Church is looking to make significant changes to its structures and processes and in order to do this, pastoral charges like BUC have been asked to provide their input.

There are five United Church Remits that must be voted on by Pastoral Charges. As a reminder they include:

1. Three Council Model
2. Elimination of Transfer and Settlement
3. Office of Vocation
4. Funding a New Model
5. One order of Ministry

These remits require that BUC council vote on behalf of the congregation as to whether to accept these changes to the United Church. Remits 1 & 2 were discussed and voted on at the Council meeting in April while Remits 3 & 4 were discussed and voted on in May. Council voted to approved the changes for Remits 1, 2, 3 and 4 and the results of these votes have been received by the office accepting these remits in Toronto.

Remit 6 remains and will be discussed and voted on by Council in the fall in order to make the February deadline. More information on this final remit will be passed on prior to this vote to allow members of the congregation time to provide input if they so wish. Stay tuned....

BUC Survey Results

As you are aware, a survey was distributed in May to help determine the willingness of BUC to share its facilities with the Good Shepherd Barrhaven Church. The responses received were greatly appreciated by Council so thank you to those who took the time to fill out this survey.

The BUC Council has heard your feedback. Based on the results, the BUC Council has decided not to proceed at this time with this request. The hope is that BUC will continue to be open to opportunities and possibilities for sharing in the future as BUC continues to receive similar requests of this nature. In order to perhaps determine how best to approach such opportunities, the BUC Council is looking at forming a small group to explore how other churches share their time and space and to consider reasons (e.g., financial, Christian community) that will be mutually beneficial as well as to best address concerns that were brought up by the congregation during the survey.
